#### WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS POINTS

**Global:** The nation of Fiji, currently at 90% lockdown. Our friends and partners with Ambassadors for Christ, South Pacific; Fiji College of Theology and Evangelism; Association of Fiji Bible Churches; the Seehusen Family (missionaries to Fiji); all associated ministries, such a Christian Helps, Bible Camp, and the Farmland.

**Domestic:** That the grace of God would be known through meaningful and profitable Christian witness amidst the ongoing "racial" tensions

**Parachurch:** CareNet Pregnancy Center of Dane County and the Elizabeth House

**Ecclesial:** Wisdom and discernment for local churches as they navigate the present social, political, and religious milieu and seek to carry out the purposes of the church

Unreached People Group: The Adi Dravida (Tamil) of India who largely congregate in the southern tip of India, number near 9M. Considered a "pariah" caste, most of this people group practices Hinduism. They also are an agricultural and simple craftsman people. Pray that they might yearn for rest in their souls through Jesus and find provision for vocational and educational needs. Also for encouragement for Christians in the region, and increased number and boldness in Christian witness.

**Discipleship Practice:** Evangelism; pray over your neighbors, co-workers, and other daily/weekly interactions.
