WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS POINTS

Global: The impoverished, orphaned, widowed, or oppressed. That God will execute justice, give food, set the oppressed free, support the fatherless, loosen the bonds of wickedness, break every yoke of bondage, and do such through his people (see Psalm 146:7–9, Isaiah 58:6–7).

Domestic: For professional athletes. For the Christians among them to remain steadfast in the grace of the gospel, and use their influence profitably. For those who remain apart from Christ, to repent and turn to the Lord in faith.

Parachurch: Missionary support organizations (training, encouragement, translation, missionary aviation)

Ecclesial: For Pakistani pastors, and specifically the pastors in Toba Tek Singh of the Punjab region, and the pastors of Agape Church (Pastor Yaqoob Sharoon). For all the Christians of Pakistan, and especially of the Punjab region, to endure faithfully under mistreatment and persecution, to experience God's kindness and provision in their lives and families, to grow in the love and knowledge of Christ, and to find favor among their enemies.

Unreached People Group: The Punjabi-speaking people groups of Punjab, Pakistan, such as the Jat. This region, along with several regions in India, contain the most numerous and largest unreached (minimal Christian influence and missionary work) people groups in the world.
