WEEKLY PRAYER COMMUNIQUE

Global: For health organizations to conduct themselves in wisdom, honor, integrity, and with recognition for principles of freedom, democracy, and human flourishing.

Unreached People Group: Pray for the blind, deaf, and mute, and all with any debilitation that hinders communication and fellowship, that they be recognized in honor, and have needs met in dignity, and offer their capacity to society and the church.

Ecclesial: Pray for a good and proper practice of The Lord's Supper to flourish in the church, and for the church to display the unity appropriate to those joined to God and one another by the sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Parachurch: Pray for individuals and Christian ministries who work with immigrants, refugees, and the otherwise displaced. Pray for wisdom to dispense of mercy, compassion, justice, and proclamation of the gospel. Pray emigrants to experience Christian hospitality, to receive necessary aid, and to participate as contributive citizens.

Domestic: Pray for those contributing to, and suffering under neighborhood violence. Pray for the aggrieved to find comfort, provision, and wisdom to benefit their communities. Pray for the aggressors to repent and find forgiveness in Jesus Christ, and instead act courageously and stand against evil, and to desire to love their neighbors, rather than oppress.

Local: Pray for J1 students to receive an impactful witness from the church, and that many would confess Jesus as Lord and return to their countries as ambassadors for Christ. Pray for business owners and employers to act justly toward employees and especially foreign students.

Discipleship Practice: Appreciation. Pray that God's people would show appreciation and recognition of one another as equal members of the body of Christ.
