### WEEKLY PRAYER AND REFLECTION

This week reflect on... the Goodness of God.

Vital to our understanding of all things pertaining to life is understanding the goodness of God. From out of this lens, we can see things in their proper light and full of hope... even those things that are the most challenging and difficult.

Consider that God, "...did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all..." (Romans 8:32), we too can conclude with Paul in this verse that, "...how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" May this truth guide your perspective throughout this week and continually.
